



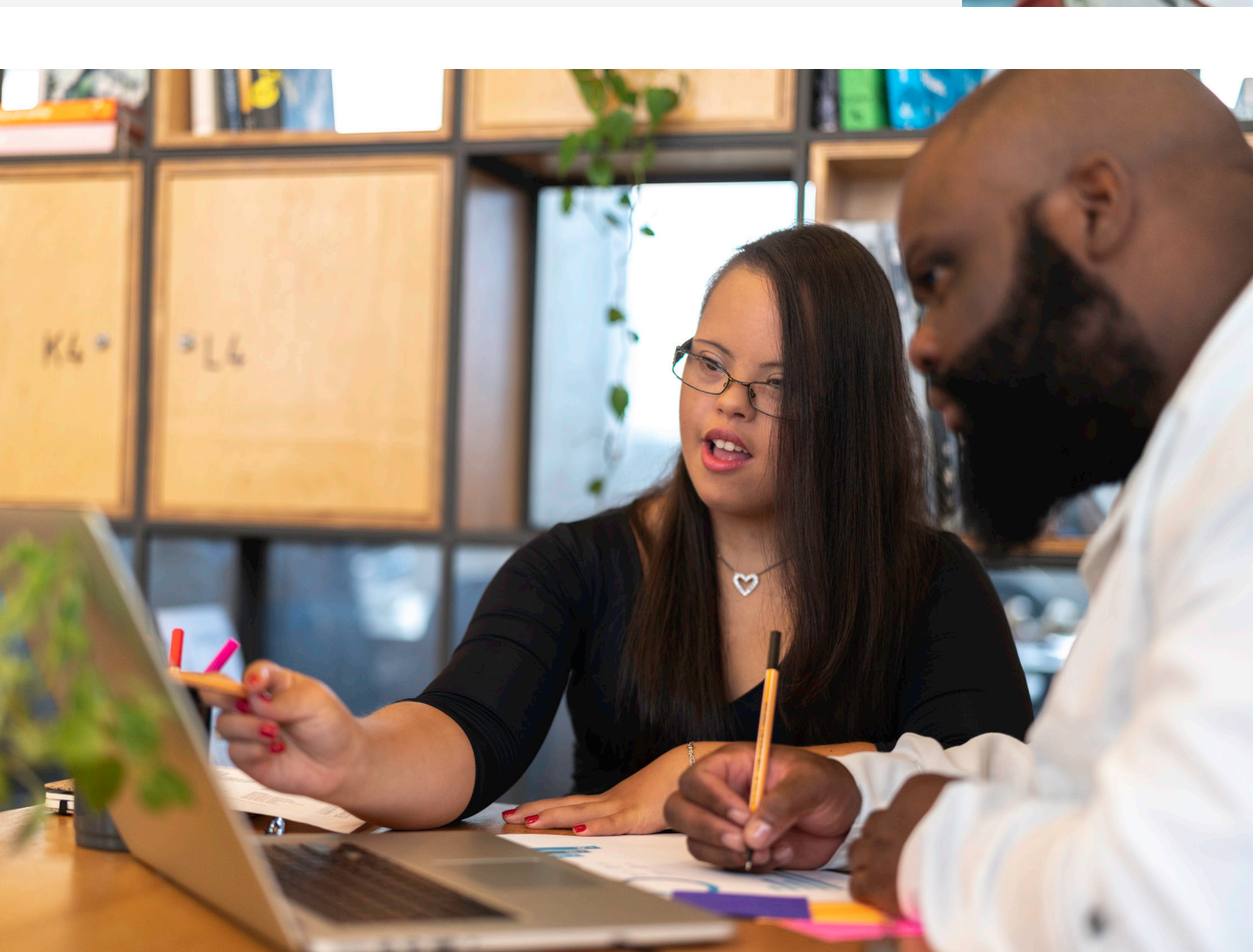

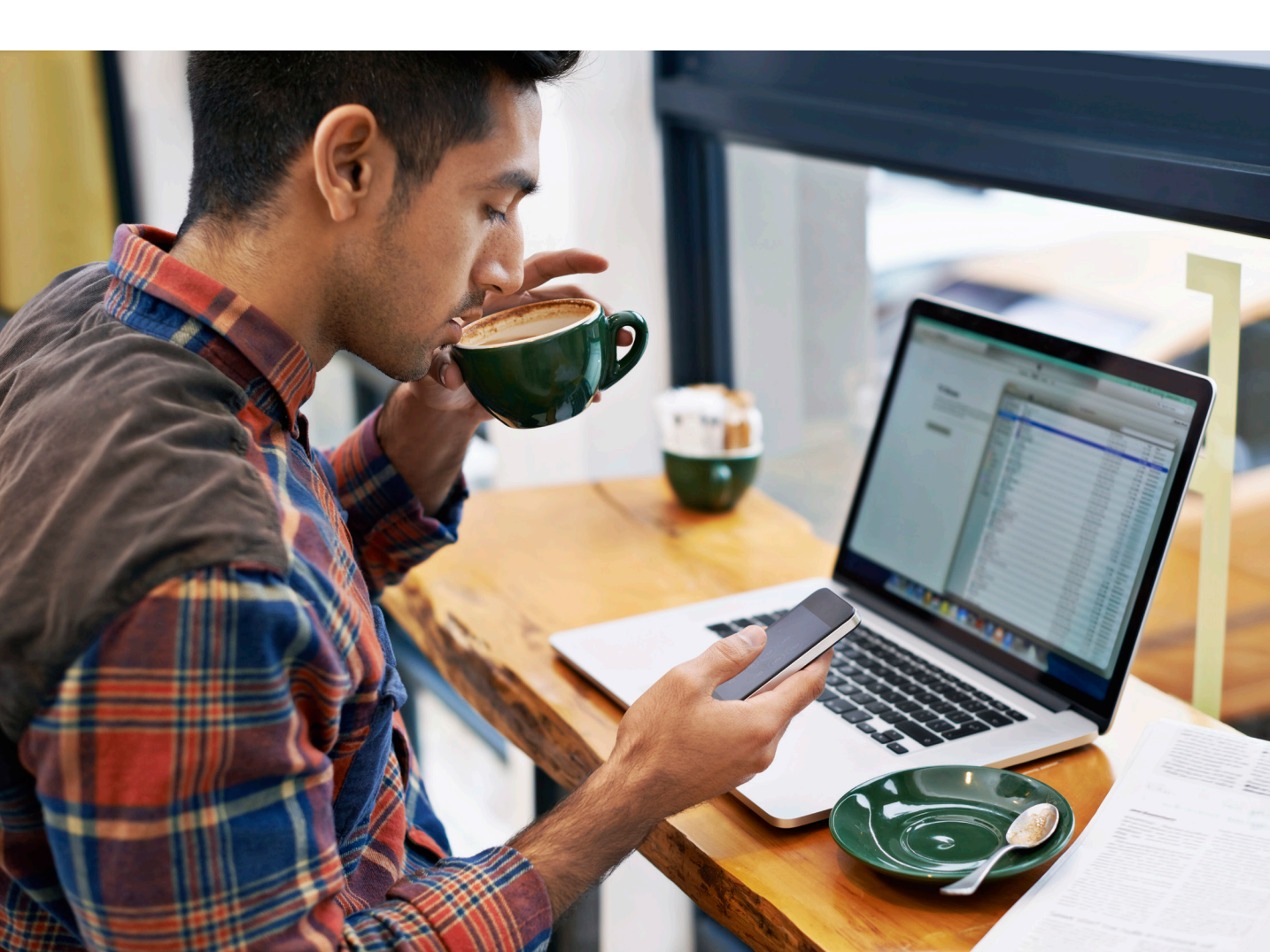

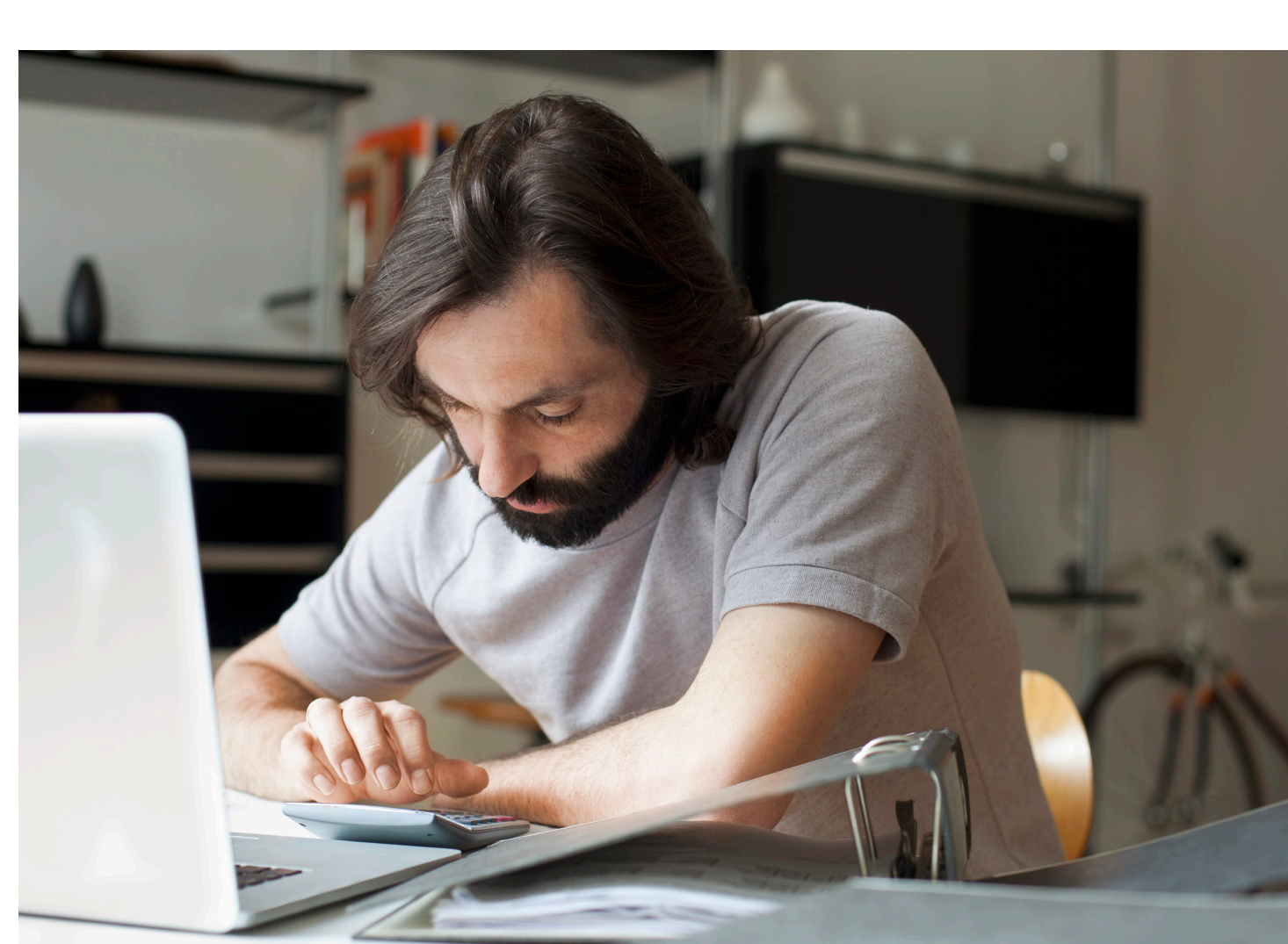

Online training and learning will rise for both the employed and unemployed*

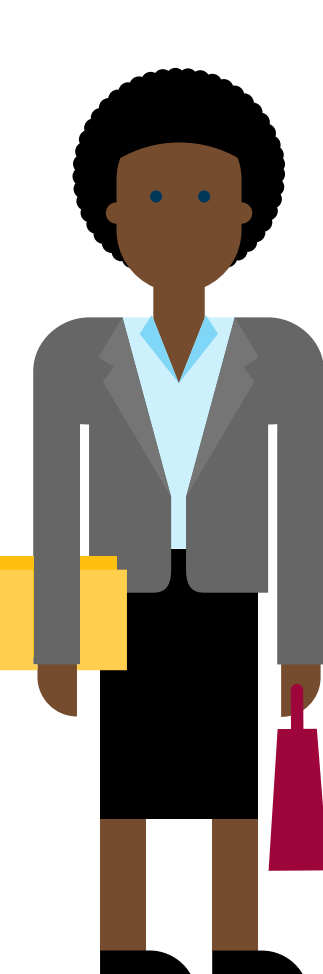

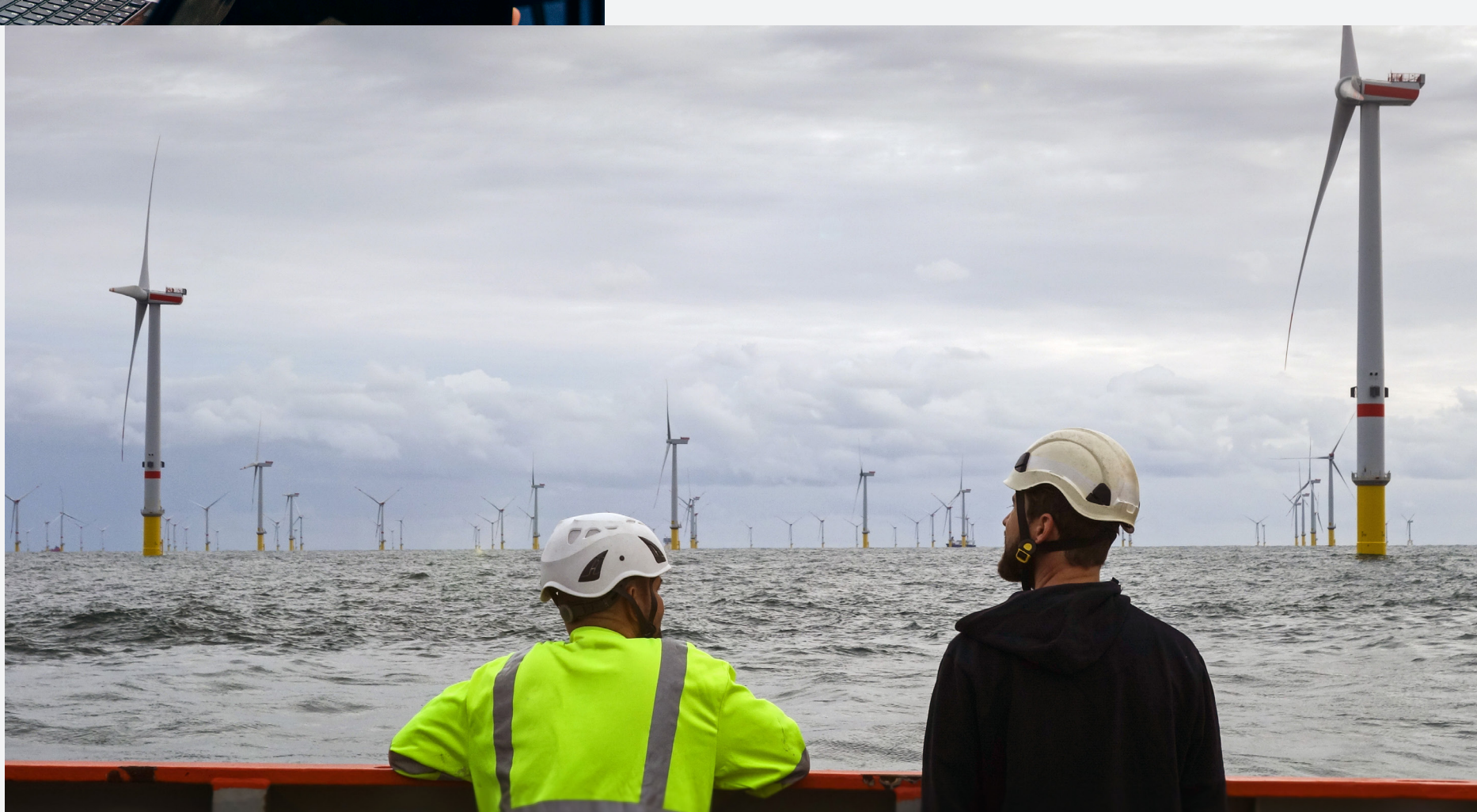
